Bed Turning Display - Rules & Entry Information

A Bed Turning is a “Show & Tell” for quilts. These quilts are NOT judged but are on display only. There are no prizes or ribbons awarded. Quilts are layered upon a bed. A narrator reads the story of each quilt, two volunteers will hold up the quilt for everyone to see. The stories behind the quilts can be as simple as a combination of beautiful colors or an intricate pattern, or a “first quilt”, a quilt from childhood, a quilt with a special meaning, an antique quilt, or a “just because” quilt. After the story of each quilt is read, the quilt is set aside and the next quilt is picked up. The Bed Turning will occur twice each day during the show at 11:00am and 2:00pm. If there is an abundance of quilts, the quilts will be divided into two groups, and each group will have at least one showing per day.

An official Bed Turning Display form must be completed for each item and received by **Lynn McDonald no later than March 7, 2023**. There is no entry fee.

All entries must have an identification tag secured to the back of the piece in the lower left corner. Print in permanent ink on the identification tag: Name, address, phone number, title of work, date of completion (if known). A photo must be attached to the entry to ensure identification of your entry.

You are responsible for delivery and pickup of your entries. **Drop off entries** to Lynn McDonald at the SMQ meeting on Tuesday, March 21st between 9am-11pm. Call Lynn at 775-291-8838, if special arrangements are required.

All entries must be picked up on Saturday April 1st, 2023 between 5:00 and 6:00 PM. **No items will be released early. Bring your item pick up receipt. No entry will be released without your receipt. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

All items must be free of dirt, pet hair, stains and smoke-free.
